

Follow these simple steps for shipping

Here's how it works:

1. Gather all unopened, unmarked, undamaged diabetic test strips, lancets, and lancing pens.
2. Prepare your diabetic supplies to be picked up at your home or prepare them for free shipping.
3. Organize by manufacturer, type (test strips, lancets. Lancing pens etc.) and size (50-count, 100-count, etc.).
4. Review all expiration dates. (Please note: We cannot accept open or expired supplies.) We prefer supplies to be at least ten (10) months away from their expiration date; Any items that are 9 months or less will be rejected. Keep in mind: **The newer, the better – and the best price!**
5. Carefully inspect boxes to ensure they have not been opened, damaged or have any discoloration whatsoever.
6. **Please do not tear off any labels** as these damage the box ! Instead, with a **soft, felt-tip marker**, cross out your name and any other personal information from the label, if you feel uncomfortable sending your products with that information on them. We do remove all labels once we receive them at our facility.
7. Write in the requested information on the packing slip or on the printable version and make a duplicate copy for your records to include shipping and tracking information.
8. Insert items in a sturdy box, with bubble wrap, packing popcorn or similar materials.
